Planning Application PK08/2703/F – Gypsy and Travellers Site at “Homefields”, Hall End

I understand that the above Planning Application was sent to Wickwar Parish Council for comment. It is unfortunate that Rangeworthy Parish Council were not sent a copy of the application, since it will in all probability effect Rangeworthy more than Wickwar. Rangeworthy Parish Council would like to raise the following objections to the application:

1. Access to the site would have to be via Rangeworthy along a single track lane flanked, in places, by deep water filled ditches. The movement of caravans and the like would be an extremely hazardous operation. It would cause further damage to the already deteriorating surfacing of the lane.
2. The site would have a serious impact on the property shown on the maps as “Rainbow Cottage”.
3. The site is in close proximity to the main Bristol to Birmingham railway line. This renders it both potentially dangerous for children and extremely noisy.

Your Council has recently spent a substantial amount of money enforcing the removal of a static caravan from the site. Your Council presumably does not support the application. If it does, the public perception that this was a waste of money would be fully justified.
